Crystal Residents Make Decisions in Four Municipal Races in 2016 General Election

In the Nov. 8, 2016 General Election, residents in Crystal voted in four municipal races. With all 11 precincts reporting and 100% of the vote counted, Incumbent Mayor Jim Adams won reelection with 54.9% of the vote. In Section I (which includes Wards 1 and 2) Nancy LaRoche won with 54.31% of the vote. In Ward 3, John Budziszewski won with 52.86%, and in Ward 4 Julie Deshler won with 67.75%.
