IMPORTANT INFORMATION

City Hall office hours are Monday – Friday, 8 – 4:30.

There is no parking on city streets from 2 – 5 a.m. or if snowfall has exceeded 1-1/2" until the street has been plowed curb to curb.

If you have pets, a resident can have up to 3 dogs or up to 3 cats or a combo of up to 2 dogs/2 cats, over the age of 6 months. To go over these limits (up to 5 pets maximum) you would need to apply for a kennel license. Dogs, cats and ferrets must be vaccinated for rabies but no city license is required. A residence (single family or duplex) may have up to four chickens (hens only, no roosters). There is a list of requirements for proper keeping of the animals.
